



Keyboard Shortcuts in Lightroom

KEYBOARD SHORTCUT	ACTION
G	Thumbnail view in Library or the Import dialogue
L	Lights out (when the L key is pressed the first time, surrounding panels of the image are dimmed 80% by default (may be set up in preferences). A second press of the L key takes us to lights out
P	Labels the image(s) selected as “accepted” and a white flag is added to the image(s) (While importing and in the Library module)
U	Removes any flag
X	Labels the image(s) selected as “rejected” and a black flag is added to the image(s) (While importing and in the Library module)
D	Brigs us to the Develop modules
E	Loupe view: the selected image would occupy the central window of the interface.
Space Bar	Switches between fitting the image in the window or zooming to a 100% (1:1 zoom)
K	Adjustment brush in the Develop module
Shift + Z	Radial filter in the Develop module
M	Graduated Filter in the Develop module
Q	Spot removal tool
O	Activated the Overlay mask
Shift + Tab	Hides the side and bottom panels
F	The image occupies all the screen and everything else is hidden. Good to evaluate the image without any distractions.
T	Hides/ reveals the tool bar
Shift + O	Changes the colour of the Overlay mask
Numbers 1 to 5	grades the image from 1 to 5 stars, respectively
Numbers 6 to 9	labels the image in colour (red, yellow, green and blue, respectively)



KEYBOARD SHORTCUT	ACTION
F5	Hides top menu
F6	Hides the bottom slide thumbnail view
F7	Hides Left Panel
F8	Hides right panel
B	Adds selected image(s) to the quick selection in the Library module
